In the Classroom

Reading : Students will begin Module 6: "Marvels of Nature" where they will be analyzing our essential question: *What makes Earth's natural wonders exciting and unique?* Students will be reading a variety of selections that present them with information about natural features and wonders. As they read, the students will learn to appreciate the unique qualities of nature and the environment.

writing: Students will take on the role of travel agents and plan a trip to a natural wonder of their choice. They will research its history, describe what visitors might experience, and estimate the cost of the trip. By the end of the unit, students will create a clear, well-organized travel plan.

Math: Students will create line plots to accurately represent data sets and analyze them to answer questions, draw conclusions, and solve real-world problems. In addition, students will review previously learned mathematical concepts and build their ability to effectively respond to both multiple-choice and constructed response questions.
