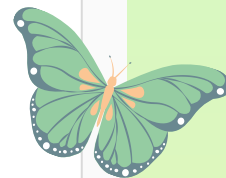

Essential Question: How can thinking in new ways help solve problems?



What we're learning

Math

In Math this month, students will use their knowledge of place value to help them solve subtraction number sentences involving 2-digit numbers. They will use various strategies such as the open number line to help them solve for the missing part in the number sentence.

Social Studies

In Social Studies this month, students will learn the importance of various parts of the community by using parts of a map. The students will be able to identify different community workers and how they work together to serve those in the community.

Reading

In Reading this month, students will recognize that good things can happen when a person is brave enough to try something new. They will read about inventors, architects, and others who have been brave and tried new things.

Writing

In Writing this month, students will be writing a biographical essay describing the life of someone who inspires them. These figures can range from historical figures to family members. They will research this figures life and accomplishments to help describe how this person inspires them.
