ELA: Module 8 - A New Home

This Month In Math

MATH: Topic 11 - Understand Volume Concepts & Topic 12 - Convert Measurements

Topic 11 focuses on volume. Students will learn how to calculate the volume of a rectangular prism and combine multiple prisms to find total volume. They'll explore the concept of a unit cube and use models to develop the volume formula—area of the base times height.

In Topic 12 students will continue to develop their understanding of customary and metric units of length, capacity, weight, and mass. This topic focuses on converting among different-sized standard measurement units within a given measurement system, as well as converting among units of time. Your student will use this understanding in solving multi-step and real-world problems
