

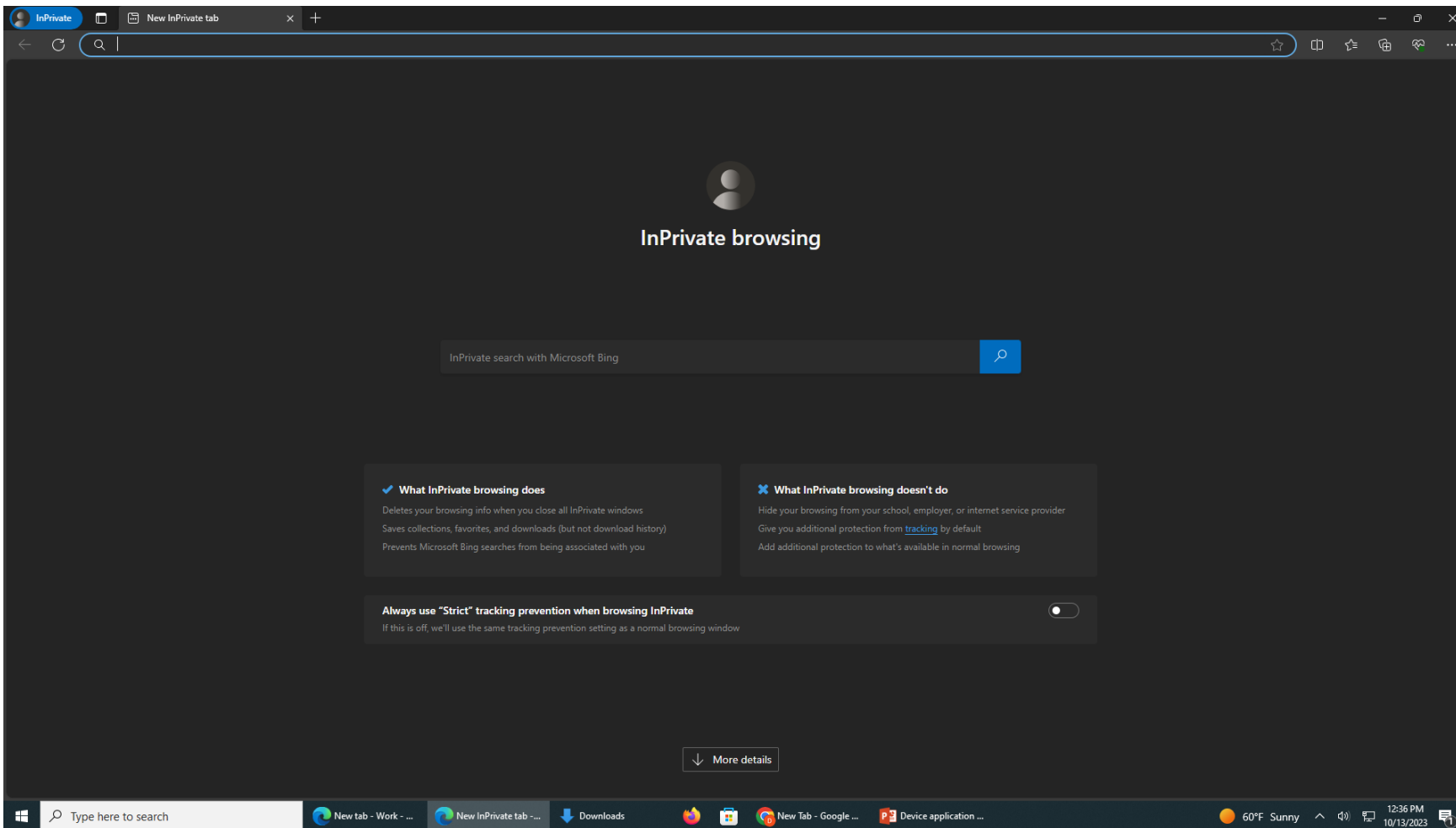
Click on dots in the upper hand corner
