Motion to approve January 2026 Meeting minutes. Approved.

- **Principal's Report (by Ms. Annio)**
 - **Student Support Programs**
We started our two morning programs this month – K to 2 with ELL and 3 to 5 with tutoring to prep for NYS Tests. After the State Tests (April and May), we will shift to enrichment programs for the mornings.
 - **I-Ready**
We are pushing the students to get their weekly I-Ready minutes completed – Minimum 45 minutes for Math and 45 minutes for ELA per week.
 - **School Construction Authority**
 - **Masonry Repair**
We are waiting for permits for the masonry repair to the outside of the school. The sidewalk shedding will be done in phases so we can use the school yard for as long as possible. They will start on Benson Ave and Bay 14th Street first and move on. The permits are delayed but should be erected at the end of this month.
 - **Cameras**
There is a Citywide initiative to install cameras inside hallways of all schools to make sure our children are safe when they are in our building. The upgrades should start during the next school year. We have been speaking to the School Construction Authority about camera locations and angles.
 - **Testing (by Ms. Guido)**
To better prepare the students for the tests, we will be conducting ELA mock assessments this month. We will also be hosting Parent Academy for grades 3 to 5 parents, to show different ways we prepare students on how to take the test on this kind of platform. We will share links with parents to see how the tests look like, to have a better understanding of what the students need. This is especially important with math because all the tools are on the computer.
