What We Are Learning:

Reading

Over the next three weeks, our class will build their knowledge about

the documents and symbols of the United States, with a focus on the

nonfiction genre. We will read texts and view videos about why certain things came to represent the values and ideals of our country.

Children will also choose three things they read about—people, places, holidays, documents, and symbols—and write an expository essay about what each means to our nation, and why.

Math

Your child is using fact families to learn division facts. A fact family has one or two multiplication facts and one or two division facts that use the same three numbers.

For example, below is the fact family for 5, 9, and 45.

 $9 \times 5 = 45$

 $5 \times 9 = 45$

 $45 \div 9 = 5$

 $45 \div 5 = 9$

Your child is learning to divide by the numbers 2 through 9 and to follow rules for 0 and 1.
